# DYNASTY COMMENCES DRILLING AT BRIGHT TO TEST GOLD REEF

**Dynasty Metals Australia Ltd (ASX: DMA)** today announced that it has commenced drilling at its Bright Gold Project located in the Bright-Harrietville Goldfields in Victoria.





Figure 2: BRIGHT GOLD PROJECT - TENEMENT LOCATION & REGIONAL GEOLOGY

The Bright Project is situated approximately 200 km north east of Melbourne (see Figure 2). Record production at historical gold mines of Bright and Harrietville Goldfields is 341,218 ounces from quartz reef sources with grade averages between 18-20 g/t Au. The Goldfield is of similar style to the Bendigo-Ballarat Goldfields with gold rich quartz reefs from < 1 m to 40 m wide, which appear to be concentrated in faults.

The combined reverse circulation - diamond drilling program will test the down plunge extension of the Victoria Reef which is one of several gold-bearing reefs within the Peabody Mine area at Bright.

Dynasty Project Geologist, Mr Alan Svanosio, said that active exploration was the key to driving value from the region's vast potential.

"There are over 250 named reefs in the Bright Goldfield and we are the first company to commence exploration and drilling in this area in over 50 years," Mr Svanosio said.

Two adits that cut the Victoria Reef, Crimean and Peabody, have been rock chip sampled along strike by a previous explorer (see Figure 3). The Crimean Adit, which is below near surface workings, produced 12 samples at an average grade of 36.60g/t gold. The Peabody Adit is approximately 240m below this adit and some distance to the south. Where Peabody cuts the Victoria Reef, 27 underground rock chip samples were collected at 1.5m intervals along 40.5m strike length. Assays range from 0.10-33.0g/t gold with an average grade of 7.50g/t gold.

"The Victoria Reef appears un-worked in the zone between the Crimean and Peabody adits – this leaves scope for the discovery of significant gold mineralisation."
