

QUARTERLY ACTIVITIES REPORT

SEPTEMBER 2016

CORPORATE ACTIVITY

Dynasty Resources Limited (Dynasty or the Company) undertook the following activities during the quarter ended 30 September 2016:

- Finalised a partially underwritten pro-rata Renounceable Rights Issue, raising \$1.15 million together with a Placement raising an additional \$1.15 million (total \$2.3 million).
- A programme of work for the bedrock drilling campaign in the northern part of North Shaw has been approved. This programme will test for lithium bearing pegmatites within the Pilgangoora lithium corridor. Drilling will commence following heritage surveys due to be completed shortly.
- \$1.5 million was contributed to the Company's subsidiary Shanghai Chen Mao Finance Lease Co Ltd (SCML), to further support SCML in the development of its financial leasing business.

EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES

Dynasty owns tenement E45/2728-I that sits adjacent to significant lithium resources in the Pilgangoora Area of the East Pilbara region in Western Australia. During the quarter Dynasty concentrated on the approval process for a drilling program in the northern part of the tenement.

This project is considered highly prospective for lithium mineralisation within lithium-cesium-tantalum (LCT) pegmatites. A program of work has been approved by the Department of Mines and Energy for 2500m of RC drilling. A heritage survey is being organised and drilling will commence as soon as practicable one completed.

This drilling is designed to test for the continuation, along strike, of the large Pilgangoora Lithium resources on ground held by Altura Mining (AJM) and Pilbara Minerals (PLS). Reconnaissance mapping discovered extensive pegmatites within the mafic units of the Sulphur Springs Group and the sediments of the Gorge Creek Group. These units are interpreted to be present under cover in the north of the tenement and may contain lithium bearing pegmatites similar to those found within the Pilgangoora resource area.




Figure 1 Simplified Geology and regional mineralisation with location of drilling program -North Shaw Project



The target of the drilling will be to identify any pegmatites in the bedrock and to test for lithium anomalies.




Figure 2 Planned Drilling program






Figure 3 North Shaw Project regional competitor map




Figure 4 North Shaw - Project location
